- It is that time of year again to remind residents who leave for the winter to put your car key(s) on your dining room table or kitchen counter, in case your car needs to be moved due to snowplowing. Other important recommendations are: (1) Shut off your Instant Hot and washing machine valve; (2) Make sure your windows are closed tightly; (3) Turn off the valve to your toilets and cover the toilet bowl with plastic wrap (Saran Wrap, etc.). Otherwise, gases will escape from the toilets. If you prefer, our Maintenance staff will winterize your unit for \$35.00.
- If you have computers, monitors, television, etc., you can call the Management Office to have your item(s) picked up at your unit and recycled for a fee of \$35/item.
- It will soon be Halloween on Saturday, October 31st. As in the past, call the Management Office and leave your name and unit number if you would like the children living at The Towers to stop by for a treat between 5:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. If you are parents of young children, leave your name, unit number, and how many of your children will be "Trick-Or-Treating."
- If you are planning to have work done in your unit, you must complete and sign a "Construction Packet" in the Management Office, after which it has to be approved prior to any work being started.
- Furniture and other items are not to be moved on nights or weekends, since our staff is not equipped to pad the elevators at these times. This is to be done Monday-Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and must be scheduled through the Management Office. The ONLY exceptions are hospital beds. No items can be left in the basement of either building. They must be taken off property, since our trash contractor will not pick these up. Residents violating this rule will be fined.
- Our "Annual International Day" will be held at the end of October between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. on the poolside deck. We are looking for residents to help organize this event! Residents are encouraged to bring an ethnic dish to the celebration. Children are especially welcome to attend. This is a special event because it is organized and presented by Towers residents.
